

Spring Turf Block



In their junior year, turf majors enroll in our spring turf block:

a 10-credit-hour group of courses offered during the first ten weeks of each spring semester, followed by an internship for the remaining five weeks of the spring semester and the summer semester.

The spring block schedule allows turf majors to finish classwork by around April 1, so that they can begin their internship around the time grass starts growing.
